Please take note of the new changes for 2011. Due to liability issues we are asking:

- Absolutely **NO** golf carts, ATV's, gators, or other motorized vehicles will be allowed on the grounds. ***HANDICAP and OFFICIALS ONLY! This will be enforced.***
- Absolutely **NO RIDING** of ***ANY*** lawnmowers, lawn tractors, tractors, or any other motorized form of transportation is allowed anywhere on the grounds unless you are participating in the parade on Saturday or Sunday. ***HANDICAP or OFFICIALS ONLY! This will be enforced.***
- ***No*** pets of ***any*** kind. ***Only service pets*** are allowed and must show proper paperwork.

Other items of interest:

- Some construction will be taking place on I-64 East and West bound from the Corydon Exit (#105) to the New Albany Exit (#120). Expect a few delays and even longer delays if coming in on Saturday after 10 am.
- Time change - Antique Tractor Parade has been moved to 2:30 on Sunday, September 11th.

We would like to thank you for your past participation in the Lanesville Heritage Weekend. Once again, we would like to ask you to participate in this year's show. **This will be our 36th year of celebrating Lanesville Heritage Weekend and we are featuring Ford Tractors/New Holland Equipment, Fairbanks Morse Gas Engines, and Westinghouse Steam Engines.** We hope you can bring something to display. If you cannot bring something to display, please plan to attend and enjoy the show.

Attention Feature Tractor Exhibitors!! For each feature tractor and/or implement displayed you will receive a chance to win one of the feature toys as shown on the enclosed flier. **Only (1) one will be given away on Sunday, September 11th.** Beat the odds and bring several! This is only for feature tractor exhibitors. ***No chances will be given to non feature exhibitors.***

Registration for tractors will not begin until Thursday at Noon.

The use of golf carts and other related vehicles will be permitted *for handicap patrons and officials for the weekend only*. These vehicles must be registered at Tractor Registration. Those patrons will need to register their vehicle and must show **proof of liability insurance**. **NO EXCEPTIONS!** Anyone not registered will be asked to remove their vehicle from the grounds immediately. This is for everyone's safety.

Our Tractor Registration building is #19 on the back of your flier. ***Exhibitors, please look at the map on the back of your flier for directions to the unloading dock which is #26.*** From the West side of town, follow Hwy 62 past the Mail Pouch Barn and turn left on Tandy then left into the grounds. From the East side of town, turn right onto Tandy then left into the grounds. Follow to the unloading dock on the right by the tractor pull areas. Our Gazebo is around the curve and on the left. It is very tight quarters around the Gazebo area. Please try to keep the main road from being blocked for Emergency and Heritage vehicles. **Exhibitors must check in at Tractor Registration before setting up their displays, please.** The tractor area by the Heritage Food Booth (just outside of 14-14A on the back of the flier) is still reserved for the Feature Tractors that will be displayed along the road. We have plenty of parking East of the road but *please ask at Tractor Registration before parking so we may help organize your displays together.* ***We do ask: please do not bring any tractor before 6 pm Tuesday evening.*** **We will not have parking passes for exhibitors.**

For those of you who wish to participate in the ***Main Parade on Saturday, September 11th*** you must call **Matt Gleitz at (812) 968-0903 before August 31st.** **Spaces are limited and when the parade is full, no more entries will be allowed!** Due to a time restriction we can only accept a limited number of entries. If you are not registered by August 31st, the Tractor Registration Booth *will not be able to place you in the Main Parade but* we can place you in the ***Antique Parade on Sunday, September 11th*** at 2:30 pm. Please plan to participate on Sunday. We would love to have you!

Tents: We would also like to ask all exhibitors to be mindful of their exhibit areas when putting up tents. Please be courteous to your neighbors and their exhibits as we are very limited on space. *We are not prohibiting the use of tents; however, we are trying to accommodate all of our exhibitors so keep your tents to a minimum.*

Trailer Parking: We are limited on space so all trailers may be parked in a designated area at St. Mary's Church downtown. **Please bring something to chock your trailers!** You will be directed to this lot after you have unloaded your exhibit. Please ask at Tractor Registration when ready. *Any truck and/or trailer parked in the Tractor Pull Pit area will be towed at your expense.* This area is highly congested during the tractor pulls Thursday, Friday, and Saturday evenings. Also, please keep unloading time to a minimum and please park in the designated areas to accommodate for other exhibitors.

Feature Toy: Our feature toy tractors are a continued hit with our exhibitors! Each year we will have a toy tractor of the year's feature tractor available for sale. **This year's feature toy is a Ford 8N Restoration Tractor.** Each tractor comes complete with a commemorative plaque. Enclosed please find an order form and a brochure that details the activities for the weekend. Check them out at Tractor Registration. In case you have missed out on a previous year's feature toy, you may also purchase them on the same order form. We do have a few left but quantities are limited. Get yours now before it's too late! They will be available at the Tractor Registration building. We will also have special Heritage Weekend Clocks available at the Tractor Registration building.

Tractor Games: **Please plan to attend the tractor games on Sunday morning at 11 am.** Games will be held on the Tractor Pull Track. Registration is not necessary. Please bring your tractor and your cheering section with you and be ready to play! *I would also like you to remind all the ladies you know to*

come and join in on the games like the skillet toss! It's not all fun and games for the guys – we can play too! See you there ladies! **Should you have any questions, please contact Zach Carrico at (502) 331-1410.** Don't forget when you are finished playing at the games to join us in the Antique Tractor Parade at 2:30 pm. The fun doesn't have to end with the games.

New Time for Exhibitor Antique Tractor Pull: This year on Saturday, September 10th at 10 am we will hold a special tractor pull for exhibitors. Tractors must be on display by 9 am Saturday morning. Scales open at 9 am on the tractor pull track. Factory out of field tractors only and tractors can pull in one class only. Classes are 5000 lb with a \$15 entry fee & 7000 lb with a \$15 entry fee. Payoff = Trophy + \$50, \$25, \$15 for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places respectively. ***These classes and prizes are subject to change without notification.*** Please see the tractor pull flier for more rules and regulations when you register your exhibit. We will have copies of this flier at Registration. For further information, call Adam Camm at (812) 267-3001

Feature Tractor Rotation: The feature tractor for 2012 will be Minneapolis Moline which will be followed by Case tractors in 2013. Copies of the tractor rotation will be available at registration.

Camping: Primitive camping is also available on a limited first come, first serve basis and is \$50 for the weekend.
